Minutes of Meeting Held
December 8, 2022

Notice of the time, date, location and agenda of this meeting to the extent then known, was duly published in the district's official newspapers, posted on its official bulletin board and filed with the office of the municipal clerk at least forty-eight hours in advance of this meeting. This meeting is being conducted in accordance with the terms and provisions of the "Open Meetings Act" of the State of New Jersey.

Call to Order: the meeting was called to order by Commissioner Couceiro at 6:22 pm. Commissioner Couceiro read "Open Meetings Act" statement. All participated in the Pledge of Allegiance. A moment of silence was observed.

Roll Call: Commissioners Couceiro, Goldman, Jamison and O'Brien were present. Commissioner Torres was absent. Board Attorney Braslow was absent.

Minutes: Minutes from the November 10, 2022 meeting: Commissioner Goldman motioned to approve the minutes from the November 10, 2022 meeting, seconded by Commissioner O'Brien. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Treasurer's Report: The bill list as well as the report (a copy of which is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein by reference) as of December 8, 2022 was presented and left on table for public review. Commissioner Jamison read the cash balances into the record. Commissioner Goldman motioned to accept the Treasurer's report and pay the bills, seconded by Commissioner O'Brien. Motion passed by unanimous consent.

Legal Report: None. Board Attorney Braslow absent.

Truck & Building/Career Department Report – read by Lt. Burmeister (a copy of the written report is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein by reference). Discussion: truck checks. All were encouraged to familiarize themselves with the gauges. Highest bid for retired #5408 on Gov. deals was \$21,200. Commissioner Jamison motioned to accept the bid, seconded by Commissioner O'Brien. Motion passed by unanimous consent.

Chief's Report: Chief O'Hara was absent. No report was received.

President's Report: Report read by President Al Chelli. A copy of the report is attached to the original minutes and incorporated by reference. New firefighter applicant Peter Guwdun was introduced to the Board. Commissioner Couceiro requested that a list of the new 2023 fire company officers be sent to the Board. Commissioners and Career Staff were thanked for their support during President Chelli's term of office.

Fire Bureau Report: Fire Official O'Brien was absent. A copy of the written report is attached to the original minutes and made a part hereof. Commissioner Goldman motioned that two spots and a hotel room for the IAAI Conference scheduled for 3/1 – 3/3/23 be reserved, seconded by Commissioner Jamison. Motion passed by unanimous consent.

Work Orders: previously addressed.

Old Business: None

New Business:

Line Item Transfers: Commissioner Jamison motioned to accept a Resolution in Title accepting the Line Item Transfers as per the attached list, seconded by Commissioner Goldman. Motion passed by unanimous consent. Roll Call vote: Ayes: Couceiro, Goldman, Jamison, O'Brien; Nays: 0; Abstention: 0; Absent: Torres.

Discussion – on new tires. Commissioner Jamison took the vehicle to a tire dealer for an opinion – which was the tires were a Michelin winter tire. Board was in agreement to see how it goes with the existing tires. If all goes well, new tires will not be needed.

Neil Brooks – Replacement heater for bay by antique truck: Commissioner Jamison motioned to move forward with the replacement quote from Neil Brooks in the amount of \$3,225, seconded by Commissioner O'Brien. Motion passed by unanimous consent.

Executive Session - Commissioner O'Brien motioned to accept the Resolution to take the Board into an executive session for the purpose of discussion of personnel matters seconded by Commissioner Goldman. Subject matter to be released when it is no longer considered privileged. Motion passed by unanimous consent at 7:01 p.m. The executive session ended at 8:21 p.m. and the Board reconvened continuing with the agenda.

Public Session:

Discussion on items that can be purchased now.

Commissioner Goldman motioned to purchase five (5) sets of gear, seconded by Commissioner Jamison. Motion passed by unanimous consent.

Commissioner Jamison motioned to purchase consumable PPE (masks, gloves, boots, etc.), not to exceed \$10,000, seconded by Commissioner O'Brien. Motion passed by unanimous consent.

Commissioner Jamison motioned to introduce the budget for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2023 and ending December 31, 2023; seconded by Commissioner Goldman. Motion passed by unanimous consent (Roll call vote – Ayes: Couceiro, Goldman, Jamison, O'Brien; Nays: 0; Abstention: 0; Absent: Torres).


Commissioner Jamison motioned to adopt a temporary budget for 2023 beginning January 1, 2023 through February 18, 2023, seconded by Commissioner Goldman. Motion passed by unanimous consent (Roll call vote –

Ayes: Couceiro, Goldman, Jamison, O'Brien; Nays: 0; Abstention: 0; Absent: Torres).

FF Marrero reminded the Board that a retirement of one career staff member and the process of hiring a new employee. Commissioner Jamison advised that the list was certified and the Board is requesting an Inter-Governmental Transfer.

Lt. Burmeister thanked the Board – tonight is his last Board meeting after 25 years – he is retiring. Commissioner Couceiro thanked Lt. Burmeister on behalf of the Board for all his years of service.

Adjournment: With no other business to come before the Board, Commissioner Jamison motioned to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Commissioner Goldman. Meeting was adjourned at 8:44 p.m. by Commissioner Couceiro.

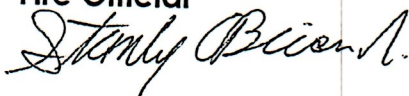

ADOPTION OF TEMPORARY 2023 BUDGET

WHEREAS, it has become necessary for the Commissioners of Fire District No. 4 in the Township of Jackson, County of Ocean, by resolution, to adopt a temporary budget to make appropriations and to provide for the period between the beginning of the fiscal year January 1, 2023 and the adoption of the budget by the legal voters of the fire district, which election is scheduled for February 18, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED by the Commissioners of Fire District No. 4 in the Township of Howell, County of Monmouth, as follows:

- (1) A temporary budget is hereby adopted to be effective from the beginning of the fiscal year as noted above and to be in full force and effect until the adoption of the annual fire district budget as referenced above; the total of the appropriations of the temporary budget to reflect not in excess of 14% of the total of the appropriations made for all purposes in the budget for the preceding fiscal year exclusive of appropriations for interest and debt redemption charges and capital improvements.
