Minutes of Meeting Held July 11, 2024

Notice of the time, date, location and agenda of this meeting to the extent then known, was duly published in the district's official newspapers, posted on its official bulletin board and filed with the office of the municipal clerk at least forty-eight hours in advance of this meeting. This meeting is being conducted in accordance with the terms and provisions of the "Open Meetings Act" of the State of New Jersey.

<u>Call to Order</u>: the meeting was called to order by Commissioner Torres at 6:06 pm. Board Attorney Braslow read the "Open Meetings Act" statement. All participated in the Pledge of Allegiance. A moment of silence was observed.

Roll Call: Commissioners Jamison, Couceiro, Goldman, O'Brien and Torres were present. No commissioners were absent. Board Attorney Braslow participated via remote communication.

Minutes: Commissioner Goldman motioned to accept the minutes of the June 13, 2024 meeting with one correction (CORRECTION: p.2: Executive session, Motion was made by Commission Goldman and seconded by Commissioner Jamison), seconded by Commissioner Jamison. Motion passed by majority vote with Commissioner Torres abstaining due to his absence from that meeting and Commissioner Couceiro (did not review minutes prior to meeting). A copy of the minutes is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein by reference.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> The bill list as well as the report (a copy of which is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein by reference) as of July 11, 2024 was presented and left on table for public review. Commissioner Jamison read the cash balances into the record. Commissioner O'Brien motioned to accept the Treasurer's report and pay the bills, seconded by Commissioner Goldman. Motion passed by unanimous consent.

Legal Report: Board Attorney Braslow reported to the Board that he sent over a proposed Resolution for Authorizing Creation of Positions of Deputy Fire Chief and Clerk 1. Accepting the Resolution means that the position(s) are created. It does not mean the position has to be filled. Commissioner Jamison moved to accept the Resolution as presented, seconded by Commissioner Goldman. Ayes: Goldman, Jamison, O'Brien, Torres (for clerk only); No: Torres (for Deputy Chief), Abstain: Couceiro; Absent: None. Motion passed. Board Attorney Braslow will send Notice out to newspaper and there will be a hearing held at the next meeting (August 8, 2024).

<u>Truck & Building:</u> Captain Leonard read his written report. A copy of the written report is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein by reference. Call Volume is now being included in the report. Commissioner Torres read the attached letter from Lt. Porth requesting that 11 Scott 4.5 30 min SCBA bottles. Commissioner Goldman motioned to accept a Resolution in Title approving the items listed in Lt. Porth's attached list authorizing disposal as per Schedule A, seconded by Commissioner O'Brien. Motion was approved by unanimous consent.

<u>Chief's Report:</u> Chief Lubertazzi was absent. No written report was submitted. Deputy Chief Stan O'Brien Sr verbally reported that they are doing good.

<u>President's Report:</u> President Robert Chojmacki provided the Board with a copy of the Company's Profit and Loss for the first two quarters of 2024 (January 2024 – June 20240. A copy of the Profit and Loss report is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein by reference.

<u>Fire Bureau:</u> Fire Official O'Brien read his report. A copy of the report is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein by reference. Discussion on fees for Smoke Certs for residential resales. Per Board Attorney Braslow, fees should be listed in Jackson Township ordinance. Board Attorney Braslow asked that all paperwork associated with this issue be forwarded to him by FO O'Brien.

Work Orders: Captain Leonard reported that as tissues are reported, work orders are addressed.

Old Business: Fire Recovery Billing – Question raised by Lt. Porth – if bill is not paid, does it go into collections. Discussion. Residents/Businesses/Taxpayers of the township will not be put into collections. Non-residents/non-taxpayers are to receive a bill. FF can take pictures with their tablets of the Driver's License, Registration, and Proof of Insurance. Lt. Porth to make a punch list with this info. Update on new engine: Lt. Porth can advise vendors that the earliest that a contract can be signed would be March 2025.

New Business: Career Fire Fighters want to discuss Metrics/Benchmarks for 12-hour shifts. Commissioner Torres is able to sit down with them. If anyone else is available, (only one more Commissioner may attend), please let him know that you are interested. Hiring of new career fire fighter: Lt. Porth has developed a standardized interview package. Discussion. Board Attorney Braslow requested the documents so he can review the documents prior to them being used. Commissioners reviewed the package (except Commissioner O'Brien). Commissioner Couceiro motioned to accept the standardized interview/hiring package as presented so long as no legal recommendations are made, seconded by Commissioner Goldman. Motion

passed by majority vote with Commissioner O'Brien abstaining. Interview of firefighter candidates: two Commissioners to participate. Date to be determined, Cheryl to notify candidates. Commissioner Couceiro motioned to schedule a special meeting on Tuesday, July 23, 2024 at 6 pm to discuss and take possible formal action on the appointment of position of firefighter.

- (5) This resolution shall take effect following final adoption and publication pursuant to

New Jersey statutory law.
